Barb Conroy retired from the Boulder Valley School District where she served as Assistant Superintendent of Learning Services. Her 36-year career in public education included leading an alternative high school for dropouts; principal of Centennial Junior High in Boulder Valley; and Director of Curriculum and Executive Director of Learning Services in Adams 14. She was part of a project which provided leadership in developing Colorado's teacher evaluation model. She also helped develop CASE's original Evaluator Training program. Moreover, she served six years on the Colorado Standards and Assessment Development and Implementation (SADI) Council.

Learn about effective staff and teacher evaluation methods

Participants will:

- ♦ Examine the requirements specified in CDE's rules and regulations pertaining to teacher induction, staff development, and teacher evaluation.
- ♦ Examine the relationship between supervision and evaluation, as well as quality instruction and school improvement.
- ♦ Review models of supervision and evaluation relative to standards-based practice.
- ♦ Learn a variety of strategies to support and coach teachers for improving individual and organizational results.
- ♦ Enhance observation and conferencing skills, including skills for providing effective feedback.
- ♦ Identify key factors to consider in evaluation report writing and other written communication associated with supervision and evaluation.
- ♦ Enhance skills for managing the supervision and evaluation process.

Note: Any changes to the educator evaluation system that come about through the 2010 legislation, the decisions of the Governor's Council for Educator Effectiveness, or the recommendations of the School Leadership Academy Board will be addressed in this series.
